CRITICAL ACTIONS

A. (USE) A BOMB THREAT IS RECEIVED BY PHONE:

- 1. Remain calm. Keep the caller on the line for as long as possible.
 - **DO NOT HANG UP**, even if the caller does!
 - DO NOT USE TWO-WAY RADIOS OR MOBILE PHONES. Radio signals can detonate a bomb.
 - DO NOT TOUCH OR MOVE A SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE.
- 2. Listen carefully. Be polite and show interest.
- 3. Try to keep the caller talking to learn more information.
- 4. If possible, write a note to a colleague to call the authorities or, as soon as the caller hangs up, immediately notify them yourself.
- 5. If your phone has a display, copy the caller ID number and/or letters on the window display.
- 6. Complete the Bomb Threat USE SHEET immediately. Write down as much detail as you can remember. Try to get callers exact words.
- 7. Immediately upon termination of call, DO NOT HANG UP, but from a different phone, contact authorities immediately with information and await instructions.

B. (USE) SPOTTING INDICATORS OF A SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE:

- No return addresses
- Excessive postage
- Stains
- Strange odor
- Strange sounds
- Unexpected delivery
- Poorly handwritten
- Misspelled words

- Incorrect titles
- Foreign postage
