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CRITICAL ACTIONS

A. (USE) A BOMB THREAT IS RECEIVED BY PHONE:

1. Remain calm. Keep the caller on the line for as long as possible.
 - **DO NOT HANG UP**, even if the caller does!
 - **DO NOT USE TWO-WAY RADIOS OR MOBILE PHONES**. Radio signals can detonate a bomb.
 - **DO NOT TOUCH OR MOVE A SUSPICIOUS PACKAGE**.
2. Listen carefully. Be polite and show interest.
3. Try to keep the caller talking to learn more information.
4. If possible, write a note to a colleague to call the authorities or, as soon as the caller hangs up, immediately notify them yourself.
5. If your phone has a display, copy the caller ID number and/or letters on the window display.
6. Complete the Bomb Threat USE SHEET immediately. Write down as much detail as you can remember. Try to get callers exact words.
7. Immediately upon termination of call, **DO NOT HANG UP**, but from a different phone, contact authorities immediately with information and await instructions.

- Stains
- Strange odor
- Strange sounds
- Unexpected delivery
- Poorly handwritten
- Misspelled words
- Incorrect titles
